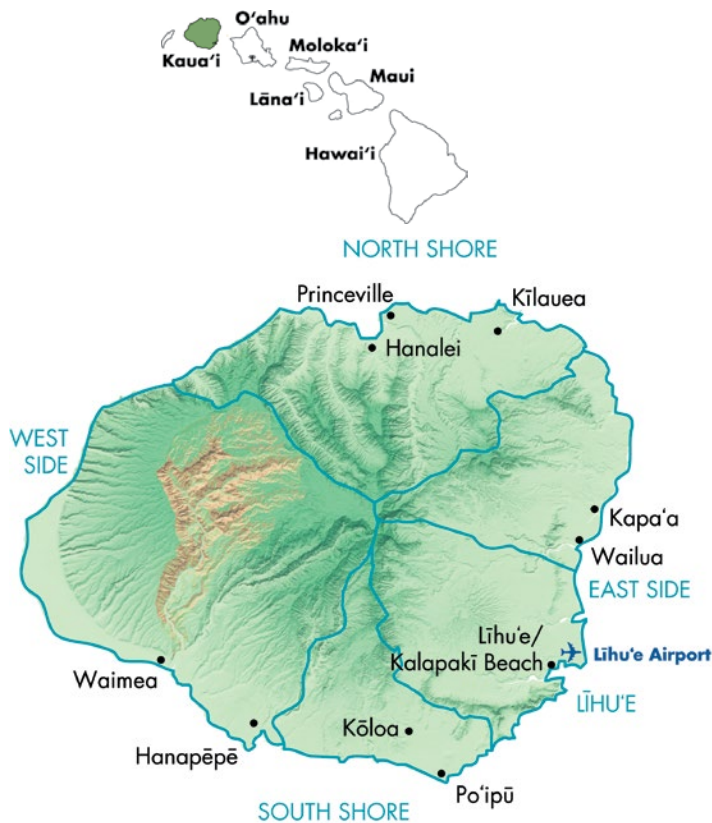


## Quick Facts: Kauaʻi
